De-Winterizing Checklist

- Deploy slideout(s).
- Rewash and wax
- Clean awning, check for tears and other damage.
- Empty all external storage areas and clean.
- Replace stored items.
- Charge battery and reinstall battery, if applicable.
- Flush all plumbing lines.
- Reset hot water heater bypass.
- Open outside fridge access door, vacuum out dust and debris.
- Check tires including spare damage, pressure and mounting.
- Grease axle bearings.
- Check suspension elements.
- Do a complete inspection of bottom of trailer.
- Check and grease steps if needed.
- Check out propane cover for proper attachment.
- Check inside and outside lights, signal/brake/running lights.
- Check roof for cracks, tears, wear or rough spots. Clean and repair any roof issues.
- Open all cupboards and drawers and remove all items. Sort, repair, replace.
- Vacuum interior including all storage areas.
- Dust blinds and all horizontal surfaces.
- Clean kitchen surfaces.
- Clean toilet, tub, all sinks.
- Clean windows, check for operation and damage.
- Wipe out fridge and replace baking soda.
- Check closure and latch operation on all drawers, doors and storage areas.
- Check propane connections for damage. Turn on propane, light stove first to start purging the lines, furnace next, then fridge.
- Restock dry goods in trailer.
- Check all batteries in detectors.
- Check all flashlights for proper operation and proper storage.
- Check fire extinguisher(s).
- Check status panel for proper operation.
- Clean tanks.
- Replace tank chemicals, recheck status panel.
- Clean AC filter and check AC mounting bolts.
- Make beds.
- Clean and repack BBQ and tools.
- Clean camp furniture.
- Clean dishes and store.
- Review packing list for interior and exterior supplies.
- Lubricate stabilizer assembly / gears.

Important: These are just some general guidelines on winterizing a standard unit. We always recommend that an owner consult their owners manual when doing any work or maintenance on their unit to get specific instructions on their particular make and model.
